

PATRICIA MULDOON

Patricia Muldoon is the Assistant Director of Youth Justice Services at the Youth Justice Agency for Northern Ireland. Patricia began her career in youth justice in 1998 working as a Probation Officer for the Probation Board for Northern Ireland. Prior to this she worked with young people in a range of settings including schools and training organisations. In 1999 Patricia joined Whitefield House (Juvenile Justice Board for Northern Ireland) where she worked as a social worker until 2003 when the Youth Justice Agency was formed. At this stage she moved to East Belfast as a Project Manager and remained there until 2011. In 2012 she was appointed Assistant Director for one of Youth Justice Services Belfast teams.

The Youth Justice Services directorate oversees all PPS and court ordered interventions dealing with approximately 1500 referrals per year.
