The Bedford Row Family Project works by engaging informally with people who have experienced prison or who have been affected by imprisonment. The Hospitality Centre is crucial to this initial engagement. Over time, and as trust is built, the Project offers intensive person centred support including one to one counselling, individual play therapy for children, groups for children and teens, life skills training, women and men's support groups, Christmas and Summer events, day trips, and training/capacity building in family support and crisis intervention.
